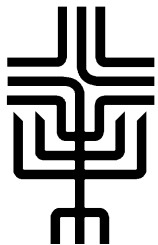

Reassuring the faithful — it's time

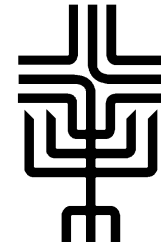

It's time to reclaim religion from extremists.

On January 22, 2008, Michigan's Senate passed SB 776. This bill:

- Is a blanket prohibition on certain 2nd trimester abortion procedures and does not include exceptions for women's health.
- Restricts doctors from using their medical judgment to decide what medical procedure is safest for each individual patient.
- Gives a green light to government interference in very personal decisions just like when Congress interfered with Terri Schiavo's case.
- Copies the current federal law, which is already in effect in Michigan.
- Jeopardizes the principle of religious liberty. For example, under Jewish law, there are some instances when an abortion is required to save the woman's life.
- Does not prevent abortions but dictates medical procedures.

Michigan Religious Coalition for Reproductive Choice...

- Brings the moral power of religious communities to ensure reproductive choice and freedom through advocacy and education.

- Was founded by clergy and lay persons from mainstream religions, many of whom provided women with referrals to safe abortion services before the Supreme Court legalized abortion.

- Supports policies that promote access to family planning services, safe and legal abortion services, sexuality education, prevent the spread of HIV/AIDS, and promote adequate health care for people regardless of income, race, gender or faith.

- Includes members who are religiously and theologically diverse, but unified in the commitment to preserve reproductive choice as a basic part of religious liberty.

We do this through:

Advocacy to remind politicians that one can be pro-choice and pro-faith.

Workshops for lay persons, students, and political candidates to provide accurate information about religious support for choice.

All-options counseling

training for clergy to serve as counselors for women facing unintended pregnancies.
